Duties and Responsibilities: This opening is sponsored by a couple of NIH funded research projects for analyzing large-scale electronic data, including electronic health records data, public clinical trial data, and PubMed Literature for phenotype knowledge discovery and integration. The ideal applicant is expected to work closely with the principal investigator Dr. Chunhua Weng to develop and disseminate impactful informatics methods and systems through quality publications and open-source software. There will be opportunities to collaborate with open science consortiums such as OHDSI (www.ohdsi.org), eMERGE, and All of Us.

Position Qualifications: Suitable postdoctoral applicants

1. Strong computational background is expected. Should hold a Ph.D. in Computer Science or Engineering, Data Science, Biostatistics, Informatics, or Information Science; or an M.D. with a strong computational or data science background;
2. Should be familiar with common programming languages such as Java, Python, R, etc.
3. Should be experienced with modern statistical analysis, data mining and machine learning methods and can implement or innovate methods on these topics
4. Should have had at least one quality peer-reviewed publications in well-respected journals or conference on related computational methods;
5. Foreign applicants should have excellent written and oral English communication skills
6. Are preferred to have prior experience with data mining and large-scale data analytics
7. Should be able to have good team working skills to interact with interdisciplinary teams
