Preface

The 2009 2nd International Congress on Image and Signal Processing (CISP'09) was held during October 17-19, 2009 in Tianjin, China. Tianjin is a financial and commercial center in Northern China. It has experienced a dramatic modernization in the past thirty years. At this dynamic city with a long and splendid history, CISP'09 turned out to be a big success. The conference attracted a total of 2030 submissions from over 30 countries and regions. After rigorous reviews, 1092 high-quality papers were accepted and included in the CISP'09 proceedings, which represents an acceptance rate of 53.8%.

CISP'09 was jointly held with the 2nd International Conference on BioMedical Engineering and Informatics (BMEI'09).
